Electrawinds sells electricity on Belpex' Day-Ahead Market

OSTEND/BRUSSELS – The green energy company Electrawinds has obtained a licence to trade electricity on the Belgian electricity exchange Belpex. Via this trading platform, Electrawinds can conclude short term contracts for the purchase or sale of electricity.

Yesterday, Electrawinds sold its first volumes via Belpex' trading platform. Those volumes will be produced and supplied today.

The entry of Electrawinds on Belpex' spot market gives the green energy producer more flexibility in controlling a part of its production and allows it to reduce its imbalance costs.
